It is designed to recognize and assist outstanding prospective and incoming students who have received an offer to the MBA or MBA with Co-op Program in the first or second round of admission. Top students, selected by the MBA Recruitment and Admissions Team, are invited to apply for this prestigious competition.

The DeGroot MBA Admission Scholarship Competition encompasses a limited number of awards in the range of **\$2,000 to \$15,000** and an opportunity for the first-place winner to have a shadow experience with Adam Felesky '99, Co-Founder and CEO, Portage Ventures (as permitted).

HOW TO APPLY

In Round 1, selected candidates will be asked to submit a Video Application in response to a question provided by Gillian Mulvale, Associate Dean, Graduate Studies and Research, DeGroot School of Business and John Medcof, Director of the MBA Program. A smaller subset of candidates will be selected to move to Round 2.

In Round 2, these finalists will move forward to the virtual interview where a small panel of DeGroot MBA Alumni will interview and rank all finalists.

AWARDS

If any student receiving an admission scholarship declines their offer, the award will be reallocated based on the final round rankings.
